Further specifications for the preparation of manuscripts:

1. Language. As publication will be in English, manuscripts, tables and graphs are to be submitted in English. Should you prefer to submit your paper in another language, translation can be undertaken by us at a rate of Dfl. 220.- per 1000 words. The translated text would be sent to you for approval prior to printing.
2. Length. To keep the size of the book within reasonable limits, the length of the paper (including illustrations, tables and bibliographic references) should not exceed 5 printed pages. For your guidance may serve that a printed page contains 600 words, or 40 references, or 55 lines of tables, or 12½ x 19½ cm of illustrations.
3. Proofs. These will be submitted to you in due course for your final checking. Please avoid alterations at the proof-stage, as the cost involved will have to be charged to you. If new results, findings etc. would make updating desirable, it would be preferable to add a paragraph or explanatory note.
4. Please send us your manuscript, clearly labelled Allergology, before September 24, and address it to:

5. Manuscripts failing to meet the standards set out in the guidelines and the above points 1 and 2 may have to be excluded from publication.
