a) Positions for "VISITING SCIENTISTS" (from three months to one or two years)

Open to foreign scientists desiring to cooperate actively with research projects, with training of postgraduates and a program of seminars and lectures. This activity is offered in the following areas of research:

- I AMINOACID METABOLISM OF BRAIN during various conditions and psychotropic drug treatment.
- II ATHEROSCLEROSIS: effect of drugs, correlation between biochemical changes of arteries and lesions; symptoms present in atherosclerotic animals.
- III BIOCHEMICAL EFFECTS INDUCED BY DRUGS IMPAIRING THERMOREGULATION with particular emphasis on lipid and carbohydrate metabolism.
 - IV CANCER CHEMOTHERAPY: development of new models for approaching the problem of cancer metastasis; effect of drugs on dissemination, transport and implantation of tumoral cells.
 - V PSYCHOTROPIC DRUGS: mechanism of action at biochemical level with emphasis on serotonin and catecholamines in brain.

b) Position for "POSTGRADUATE TRAINING FELLOWS" (from three months to one year)

Open to foreign postgraluates desiring to receive practical training in the following methods:

- I CHROMATOGRAPHIC TECHNIQUES: mainly gas-chromatography and thin-layer chromatography for amino acids, fatty acids and steroids.
- II LIPID METABOLISM: methods of analysis for free fatty acids, cholesterol, cholesterol esters, triglycerides and phospholipids; experimental atherosclerosis in various animal species; effect of drugs on lipid metabolism and atherosclerosis.
- III RADIOISOTOPE TECHNIQUES with emphasis on the use of tritiated compounds for studies of drugs metabolism and effect of drugs on catecholamine uptake, storage and excretion.

 - V CANCER CHEMOTHERAPY: evaluation of effect of antitumoral agents on neoplastic and normal tissue "in vitro" and "in vivo".
- VI PHARMACOLOGICAL TECHNIQUES: a) with emphasis on evaluation of anti-inflammator, analgesic, antiserotonin, antihistamine, bronchodilator, antipermeability and antidepressive drugs; b) with emphasis on drugs affecting the cardiovascular and gastrointestinal system.
